The show has been curated by the London based duo Silo Studio, formed by Attua Aparicio and Oscar Wanless. They are focused in the study through experimentation with industrial materials and processes aiming to adapt them to a more craft approach. Silo look at how industry makes things, trying to find a simpler and more expressive way, seeing new potential. Hand made-high tech.

During the opening event Silo will be doing live demonstrations. They will be making Newton's Bucket bowls as well Blowing Textile Moulded Glass.
